Just a reminder for contagious illnesses and the period of time children should be absent from school:

- Chicken Pox – return to school 5 days after the onset of the rash
- Scarlet Fever – return to school 48 hours after antibiotics have started
- Strep A – return to school 48 hours after antibiotics have started

Ready

Be ready for school, be on time and dressed appropriately with the items you need for the day.

Respectful

Listen to others, use appropriate language, look after the building and objects within. Keep hands and feet to yourself.

Follow the rules for health and safety for yourself and others. Be in the right place at the right time.
